

Regulations for the Use of Refrigerators and Freezers in Student Dormitories

For the maintenance of the collective interests of resident students and the safety of all residents, the university's student dormitories shall establish regulations for the use of public refrigerators to be followed. The Housing Services Office is not responsible for safeguarding the contents of the refrigerators, and no objections will be entertained in case of loss or disposal of refrigerator contents. Violation of the following refrigerator usage regulations will result in the confiscation of the refrigerator privileges and a warning.

When you open the refrigerator door and place items for storage, it signifies that you have read and understood the usage regulations.

1. When placing items in the refrigerator, they must be placed inside a container (fresh-keeping box) with a label affixed prominently on the container (room number, name, and date of placement).
2. For example: 2-201-1 Lin Xiaolin 2023.02.13~2023.03.13 (Please follow this template).
The refrigerator in the dormitory will be cleaned daily without the need for notification through broadcasting or any platform.
3. Once the date on the label of the fresh-keeping box exceeds one month, all items inside the box will be discarded without any objection.
4. In case of damage due to improper use, repair or compensation will be made according to the cost.

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
